General Data Protection Regulations 2018

'Emails - How we use your Information'

Rosliston Astronomy Group (RAG) holds a limited amount of personal data relating to individuals who wish to receive information electronically about the Group's activities, events and programme of Meetings.

The Lawful Basis on which RAG holds this information is that of Consent.

The names and email addresses of individuals are provided by them on a voluntary basis, and held securely by the Mailing List Manager for the Group. These email addresses are added to the Group's General Mailing List for the sole purpose of giving information to Members and Non-Members. Personal details are not released to any other party.

RAG's management of electronic details complies fully with the PECR (Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations).

Rosliston Astronomy Group will review this information every three years in a set sequence, or sooner if an individual's personal details change within that time. People electing to join the General Mailing List within a three year cycle will have their personal details looked at again at the time of the next three year review, and then every three years in sequence after that.

Individuals may ask for their personal details to be removed from the RAG General Mailing List at any time.
